### **School Circular for May (F.5)**

Please take note of the following issues.

#### **(1) Special Timetable for 18<sup>th</sup> May 2018 (Friday)**

18th May (Friday) will be the special timetable day, class will dismiss at 1p.m.. School Development Meeting will be held in the afternoon and there will be no school in the afternoon. Students who fail to submit their homework on that day need to stay at school to do homework from 2:00p.m. to 3:00p.m. on that day.

#### **(2) The Feast of Our Lady Mary Help of Christians**

The Feast of Our Lady Mary Help of Christians will be held at Cathedral of the Immaculate Conception at 10:00a.m. on 25 May (Friday), which is an important religious celebration of our school. Student should arrive at the church by 9:30a.m. The ceremony will end at around 11:30a.m.. There will be no class in the afternoon. Parents are welcome to join the ceremony and praise the Lord. #### **(3) Physical Education examination of the final term**

The Physical Education examination of the final term (written test) is scheduled to conduct in the morning session of Class teacher period on 29<sup>th</sup> May (Tuesday)(Day 4). Other assessment is scheduled to conduct during the P.E. lessons. In case of bad weather, class suspension will be announced by the Education Bureau, the P.E. examination will then be postponed to the Class teacher period on 31<sup>st</sup> May (Thursday)(Day 6). Enclosed is the assessment content of P.E. subject for parents' perusal.

Any students who are absent from illness are required to submit a Sick Leave Certificate issued by a doctor together with a Parents' letter, otherwise, no marks will be given and considered as absence from school without leave. (No further make-up arrangements are scheduled for late comers)
