### **School Circular for May (F.5)**

Please take note of the following issues.

#### **(1) Arrangement for changing summer school uniforms**

It is optional for students to wear either summer or winter school uniforms between 18<sup>th</sup> April (Tuesday) and 2<sup>nd</sup> May (Monday). From 3<sup>rd</sup> May (Thursday) onwards, all students must wear tidy summer school uniforms. Please refer to the "Summer School Uniform Specifications" in the student handbook for related guidelines.

#### **(2) Special Timetable**

12<sup>th</sup> May (Friday) will be the special timetable day, class will dismiss at 1p.m.. School Self-evaluation Meeting will be held in the afternoon and there will be no school in the afternoon.

#### **(3) The Feast of Our Lady Mary Help of Christians**

The Feast of Our Lady Mary Help of Christians will be held at St. Jude's Church, North Point at 10:00a.m. on 19<sup>th</sup> May (Friday), which is an important religious celebration of our school. There will be no class in the afternoon. Parents are welcome to join the ceremony and praise the Lord. A copy of the road map of St. Jude's Church is attached at the back of this circular for your kind reference. To apply for a case leave, please refer to page 14 of the Student Handbook.

#### **(4) Catholic School Teachers' Day**

25<sup>th</sup> May (Thursday) will be the Catholic School Teachers' Day, students have no classes on the day.

#### **(5) Arrangement for F.6 students to withdraw subjects (2023-2024)**

##### **(a) Objectives:**

In order to cater for F.6 students who have learning difficulties, the school allows students to drop DSE elective subjects so that they can concentrate on the study to achieve desirable results in public examinations.

##### **(b) Application**

There are two stages for F.6 students to apply for subject withdrawal. **The first stage** starts from **23<sup>rd</sup> June to 4<sup>th</sup> July**. **The second stage** starts from **21<sup>st</sup> August to 5<sup>th</sup> September**. According to the requirement from the JUPAS, student needs to take at least two elective subjects to meet the minimum requirement of the eight local universities (see attachment). Parents should write to apply if students will remain less than two electives after the withdrawal. The school will consider the application on a case-by-case basis. (When applying for withdrawal of any electives, please note the requirement of the tertiary institute. You may refer to the attachment for reference.)

**(I) First Stage (23<sup>rd</sup> June – 4<sup>th</sup> July)**

- Students who wish to drop elective subjects can take an Application Form for subject withdrawal at the School office during the period between **23<sup>rd</sup> June and 4<sup>th</sup> July** and return the form to the School office **on or before 4<sup>th</sup> July**. The form can also be downloaded from our school website. Late application will not be accepted.
- A name list of accepted students will be posted on the notice board of the Academic affairs outside the school hall on 12<sup>th</sup> July. The listed students are required to go to the library/ designated places for self-study or tutorials starting from the specified date (to be confirmed later).
- Accepted students are not required to attend the tutorial class of that subject during the summer vacation.

**(II) Second Stage (21<sup>st</sup> August – 5<sup>th</sup> September)**

- The application procedure is the same as the first stage. Students who wish to drop an elective subject can take an Application Form for subject withdrawal at the School office during the period between **21<sup>st</sup> August – 5<sup>th</sup> September** and return the form to the School office **on or before 5<sup>th</sup> September**. Late application will not be accepted.
- The approved name list will be announced in early September. Students are required to go to the library/ designated places for self-study or tutorials after the specified date.
