To compensate for the lack of teaching hours, enhancement and remedial courses are organized after school and during holidays.

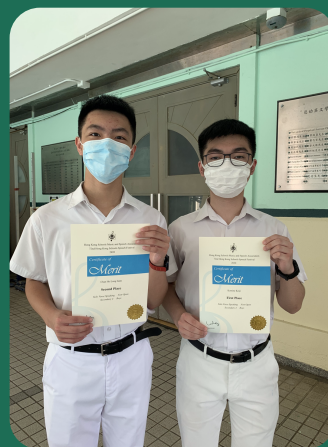
