1. **Mark Checking Day, Checking of Provisional Report Cards, Post-Exam Activities Day and students' activities during summer vacation**

Mark Checking Day, Checking of Provisional Report Cards, Post-Exam Activities Day will be scheduled from 21st June to 10th July. Students are required to return to school to attend the activities punctually as specified in the appendix.

- All forms of students are required to return to school to attend post-exam activities. The schedule please refer to post-examination programmes time-table【Appendix II】(Chinese version only)

All students are required to wear school uniforms to return to school and join the activities during the period of post-exam activities. Students who do not have any activities to participate, they are not required to return to school on that day.

2. **Diversified Learning Day (29th June 2018)**

In order to enrich the learning experience of the students, Diversified Learning Day will be organised by the Other Learning Experience Team on 29th June (Friday) . Please refer to the "Diversity Learning Day" notice distributed separately.

3. **Summer study programmes**

- To enable students to make good use of summer vacation and consolidate their study, the school will arrange a series of "summer remedial courses" for selected students in need, who are going to be promoted to F.2 and F.3. (including Mathematics and Science courses to be held in the morning of 11-13th and 16-17th July). The course is free of charge.
- In addition, the school provides "academic enhancement classes" for selected F.1 and F.2 students (to be held in the morning during 16th -20th July and 23th -27th July). Apart from providing basic Chinese and English language courses, interest classes and an one-day outdoor activities will be arranged for students to attend. All expenses are free of charge.

◇ Students who are selected to participate in summer study programmes will receive the relevant parent's letter through the class teacher on the day of the school closing ceremony.
