School Circular for May (F.3)

Please take note of the following issues.

(1) Mathematics Talk

Mathematics plays an important role in the field of Science. In order to let our students have a better understanding in the subject, we shall run a talk for our F.3 students. The talk will use daily life examples to exhibit some applications of Mathematics. Students can recognize the contents of the Extended Part of Mathematics in DSE syllabus. Therefore, they can make wise choices in their future. The details of the talk are as follows:

It is hoped that parents can urge their children to study hard so as to improve their mathematics ability.
