School Circular for December (F.6)

Please take note of the following issues.

1. The Feast Day of the Immaculate Conception

The Feast Day of the Immaculate Conception will be celebrated on 6th December (Friday). All students are required to wear winter school uniforms. Catholic students, students from the Catechism Class and Sodalities should arrive at school by 8:20 a.m. to attend the Mass in the school hall. Other students should arrive at school by 9:00 a.m. to attend the religious ceremony at the Gymnasium. After the ceremony, various ball games and other entertainment programs will be arranged for students to join until 11:30am. Students are free to return home and there will have no class in the afternoon.

2. Parents' Day

The parents' day originally scheduled on 14th December, will be postponed to 4th January 2020. Please pay attention to the notice of December for details.

3. Cross-Country Race

The Cross-Country Race will be held at Lei Yue Mun Park on 17th December (Tuesday) with an aim to train students' physical agility, stamina **and** develop their interest in long distance running. Students may wear class T-shirts or school PE uniforms, jeans or dark trousers and sports shoes to attend the event.

4. Christmas Holidays

Christmas Celebration will be held on 20th December (Friday). All students are required to return to school and participate in the "Christmas Party" before 8:30am. Programmes include religious ceremony, lucky draw, Christmas caroling, prize presentation and tea gathering, etc. All of the programmes will end at about 11:30 a.m. Students are free to return home and there will be no class in the afternoon. Students can wear casual clothes in decent manner to school and bring along their student cards.

Christmas and New Year Holidays start from 23rd December 2019 (Monday) to 1st January 2020 (Wednesday). School resumes classes on 2nd January 2020 (Thursday) (Day 1).

5. Written Examination of Ethics and Religious Studies for F6

- The mock examination of Ethics and Religious Studies for F.6 students will be held during the Class Teacher period on 7th January (Tuesday) (Day 4). (F.6 students are required to return to school as usual before 7:50 am)

- Should there be any special incidents occur during the examination, for example, class suspension announced by the Education Bureau, the examination for Ethics and Religious Studies will be cancelled until further notice.
- Students who fail to attend the examination due to sickness are required to submit a Sick Leave Certificate issued by a doctor together with a parent's letter, or no marks will be scored and furthermore, it is considered as truancy.
- No further make-up arrangements will be given to late-comers.
- Students are not allowed to bring along any mobile phone or smart watch with them during the examination (please refer to the Code of Practice for the Student Handbook). Offenders will be treated as an "attempt to cheat".
- The scope of study for the examination is outlined on the notebook of F.6 Ethics and Religious Studies.
- The arrangement for the examination of Ethics and Religious Studies will be announced to F.6 students during weekly assembly.
