School Circular for December (F.6)

Please take note of the following issues.

1. The Feast Day of the Immaculate Conception

The Feast Day of the Immaculate Conception will be celebrated on 9th December (Friday). All students are required to wear winter school uniforms. Catholic students, students from the Catechism Class and Sodalities should arrive at school by 8:30 a.m. to attend the Mass in the school hall. Other students should arrive at school by 9:00 a.m. to attend the religious ceremony at the playground. After the ceremony, various ball games and other entertainment programs will be arranged for students to join until 11:30am. Students are free to return home and there will have no class in the afternoon.

2. Parents' Talks and Counseling Period for Further Studies

3. Christmas Celebration and Christmas Holidays

Christmas Celebration will be held on 21st December (Wednesday). All students are required to return to school and participate in the "Christmas Party" before 8:25am. Programmes include religious ceremony, class-based activities and booth games. All the programmes will end at about 12:00 n.n. Students are free to return home and there will be no class in the afternoon. Students should bring along their students cards and can wear casual clothes in decent manner to school.

Christmas and New Year Holidays start from 22nd December 2022 (Tuesday) to 2nd January 2023 (Monday). School resumes classes on 3rd January 2023 (Tuesday) (Day 5).

4. Written Examination of Ethics and Religious Studies for F6

- The mock examination of Ethics and Religious Studies for F.6 students will be held during the Class Teacher period on 10th January (Tuesday) (Day 2). (F.6 students are required to return to school as usual before 7:50 am)
- Should there be any special incidents occur during the examination, for example, class suspension announced by the Education Bureau, the examination for Ethics and Religious Studies will be cancelled until further notice.
- Students who fail to attend the examination due to sickness are required to submit a Sick Leave Certificate issued by a doctor together with a parent's letter, or no marks will be scored and furthermore, it is considered as truancy.
- No further make-up arrangements will be given to late-comers.
- COVID-19 testing measures will be implemented according to Education Bureau's precautionary policies. Students should undergo the Rapid Antigen Test and complete the Record Sheet for Body Temperature and Rapid Antigen Test before going to school. On the day of the examination, the record check will be done during the class teacher period. If students have not done the test or have an incomplete record, the school has to confirm the details with the parents or arrange a RAT before allowing them to take the examination. Please note that the examination will start as scheduled, and students will bear the time loss if they need to take the Rapid Antigen Test at school.
- Students are not allowed to bring along any mobile phone or smart watch with them during the examination (please refer to the Code of Practice for the Student Handbook). Offenders will be treated as an "attempt to cheat".
- The scope of study for the examination is outlined on the notebook of F.6 Ethics and Religious Studies.
- The arrangement for the examination of Ethics and Religious Studies will be announced to F.6 students during weekly assembly.
