School Circular for June (F.3)

Please take note of the following issues.

(1) Final Examination

1. Final Examination will be held from 3rd June (Wednesday) to 15th June (Monday). 6th June、13th June and 16th June will be the reserve examination day.
2. The examination is scheduled to conduct in the morning (Students attending written examination should come to school by 7:50am and before 7:55am into the exam venues). Parents are advised to take note of the dates and time of the examination. Enclosed herewith is the final examination timetable for your kind reference. Please urge your children to prepare for the examination and try their best in the revision. (Should there be any special circumstances occurred during the examination, for example, class suspension announced by the Education Bureau, the examination affected on that date will be cancelled and the make-up examination arrangement will be announced later. The remaining examination will not be affected.)
3. Students who fail to attend the examination due to sickness are required to submit a Sick Leave Certificate issued by a doctor and a parent's letter, otherwise, zero marks will be given to the examination papers involved and will be regarded as truancy.
4. Oral examinations will be arranged as follows :

Chinese Language	The written test will be held during the exam period. Please refer to the examination timetable attached.#
English Language	The written test will be held during the exam period. Please refer to the examination timetable attached.#

Any students who are late for Chinese and English Oral examinations are not allowed to re-take. (Please refer to the documents or admission forms to be issued by the concerned subjects for details of the oral examination arrangement)

5. If students have any symptoms of cold, please let the children stay at home for rest and should consult a doctor as soon as possible.
6. Students are not allowed to bring a mobile phone or a smart watch with them during the examination (please refer to the Conduct of Examination in the Student Handbook). Students found with these items will be treated as "attempting to cheat".

(2) The scope of the examination and the revision guide for the Final Examination

Detailed information on the requirements and formats of assessment for each subject will be distributed to students for their revision by their subject teachers. Should your children have any questions, please contact their respective subject teachers. We hope that students can achieve satisfactory results through their efforts with appropriate examination strategies.

(3) Territory-wide System Assessment

The written assessments of The Territory-wide System Assessment for Chinese Language, English Language and Mathematics for F.3 students will be held on 17th and 18th June. (with 24th June as the reserve date in case of deferment due to adverse weather or other unforeseen circumstances) . Details are as follows:
